We had hoped that our buildings would have re-opened by 2022, but unfortunately this has not been the case following a resurgence of covid infections, and a new variant, Omicron. Our team have undertaken a review of Work, Health & Safety procedures and the board have endorsed the following plan.

Social support activities

We can confirm that there will be no indoor, face to face activities to be held on site at Riverstone Neighbourhood Centre. Instead, the team have negotiated some socially-distanced outdoor activities to resume from February 2022 including, dance fitness, bootcamp, gardening and yoga. Medical transport

Clients can be transported via taxi service for medical transport appointments only. Clients will not be charged for the taxi service and RNC staff will arrange booking of transport to and from the appointment.

Other services available at RNC

Food assistance

Clients cannot be transported to shopping centres to run errands or to do grocery shopping. If clients are unable to access groceries then RNC staff can drop food hamper off to clients home address. Staff are not permitted into clients' homes though. If clients are requiring a larger grocery shop, RNC staff can coordinate an online delivery from either Woolworths or Coles at the clients' expense.

Financial hardship

We understand these have been financially stressful times, particularly as our wallets recover from the Christmas holidays. If you or someone you know is struggling, please call the office on 9627 3622. Depending on eligibility, clients may be entitled to receive a food voucher or vouchers towards pharmaceuticals, gas, electricity, or water bills. Eligibility will be assessed via a phone appointment only and wait times may exceed a week.

Booster Bus

FREE Pfizer booster shots available for community members on Thursday 10th February 1.30pm-4.30pm, no appointment necessary

You are eligible for a booster vaccination if you are:

- * Fully Vaccinated (have received 2 doses of a Covid-19 vaccine)
- * Aged 18 years and over, and
- * Received your second dose of a Covid-19 vaccine at least 3 months ago
- * You need to bring proof of vaccination 1 and 2 for your booster


